### Top 10 Ranks

- 6 Science & Technology Associate Degrees and Beyond States. GOAL: Increase the proportion of Indiana residents with postsecondary credentials in STEM-related fields to "Top 5" status internationally
- 9 Mathematics Gap: 8<sup>th</sup> Grade. GOAL: Eliminate the educational achievement gaps for disadvantaged populations. Gap is the difference between test scores for students eligible and not eligible for free lunch program

#### Bottom 10 Ranks

- 46 Associate Degrees or Higher. GOAL: Increase to 60% the proportion of Indiana residents with high quality postsecondary credentials
- 43 Bachelor Degrees or Higher. GOAL: Increase the proportion of Indiana residents with bachelor's degrees or higher to "Top 10 status internationally

- 4 State Public Pension Spending. GOAL: Reform public pensions systems to achieve fairness and cost containment
- 9 State and Local Government Spending. GOAL: Enact comprehensive government reform at the state and local levels to increase efficiency and effectiveness in delivery of services

#### Bottom 10 Ranks

- 45 Urban Industrial Property Tax Rates. GOAL: Eliminate the business personal property tax
- 44 Adult Smoking Rate. GOAL: Reduce smoking levels to less than 15% of the population
